President's Message

Dear WSPR Members.

Spring greetings to our WSPR family from the warm and sunny city of Albuquerque, New Mexico, and welcome new members! I am honored to serve as your President and will continue the great work of those serving before me. The WSPR annual meeting has been going strong for 63 years! Our committed group of elected representatives and council members will ensure that we continue the tradition of

providing a supportive and collegial environment where we can share and celebrate our exciting research in pediatrics.

This past meeting in Carmel was another success with some new added features. I will highlight a few for those of you who were not able to attend.

The Carmel Research Prize

This year, the five societies (WSPR, WAFMR, WAP, WSCI, and WSMRF) sponsored a Junior Faculty (within 3-4 years into their academic career) research award competition. Four winners were chosen from among 35 stellar applicants. Winners received travel and registration coverage in addition to \$3,500 to support their research. Pediatrics was well represented. In fact, three of the four inaugural Carmel Research Prize winners' topics were related to pediatrics, and our very own, Dr. Henry Lee from Stanford University, was among them! Another WSPR member, Dr. Melanie Cree-Green of the University of Colorado was also a finalist winner!

The Fred Battaglia Honorary State of the Art Lecture

Another new item was the addition of the Fred Battaglia Honorary State of the Art Lecture (sponsored by the **University of Colorado**) to our existing **Joan Hodgman Memorial Lectureship** (sponsored by **USC/CHLA**). We are hoping to engage more Universities to support bringing preeminent State of the Art speakers to the annual meeting of the WSPR to foster young talent who will continue the next generation of pediatric physician scientists.

WSPR Abbott Nutrition Research Awards

There were also some outstanding presentations by recipients of the WSPR Abbott Nutrition Research Awards at the Plenary Session (see "Secretary/Treasurer Notes" for names of awardees). To continue showcasing the excellent research of our colleagues here in the West, please start thinking about nominating your deserving colleagues and trainees for the following awards:

- The WSPR Abbott Nutrition Young Investigator Award: This award is conferred every year to an outstanding Pediatric Scientist in the early phase (Assistant Professor) of their career. The winner receives \$1,250 and an engraved plaque to be presented at the annual meeting. The award winner will be asked to present some aspects of his/her work. Please share your brightest new Pediatric Researchers with WSPR!
- The David W. Smith Pediatric Trainee Research Award: This award is conferred every year to an outstanding Pediatric Scientist in the training phase (resident or fellow) of their career. This award includes a plaque and a \$1000 honorarium. Nominees are expected to submit an abstract to WSPR and present their work at the annual meeting.
- The Lowell Glasgow Student Research Award: This award is given to a student with the most outstanding abstract submitted to WSPR. A generous \$750 honorarium is provided to the awardee. A copy of the student's abstract must accompany the nomination letter.
- The Pediatric Resident Research Award: This award is given to a pediatric resident with the most outstanding abstract submitted to WSPR and comes with a \$750 honorarium.

WSPR Mead Johnson Travel Awards and Abbott Nutrition Subspecialty Awards
There were also some outstanding presentations by the six recipients of the WSPR
Mead Johnson Travel Awards and the eight recipients of the WSPR Abbott
Nutrition Subspecialty Awards (see "Secretary/Treasurer Notes" for names of
awardees). The purpose of these awards is to facilitate participation in the WSPR by
medical and other students, residents, fellows, and junior faculty. Mead Johnson
and Abbott Nutrition sponsor these awards, which includes \$500 to defray the cost of
attending the meeting. Abstracts are selected by the WSPR officers on the basis of
merit and ranking by subspecialty reviewers. Awardees must make an oral presentation
of the abstract at a subspecialty session of the meeting.

I am anticipating another great year with more growth in diversity within our Society. With the rolling membership application procedure in place now, you can nominate your colleagues and trainees anytime (<u>WSPR Membership Information</u>). There is no application fee and the annual meeting is an excellent time to connect with others from various disciplines and potentially create team science that may enhance your research (and funding). It really is a friendly environment and a great way to network (coming from a Myers Briggs analyzed ISTJ)!

The Executive Council will soon be teleconferencing with the other societies to start planning for the 2017 Western Regional Meeting which now has a new name, **The Western Medical Research Conference!** So save the date, January 26-28, 2017, and I will have more updates to share with you in the summer.
